

Do I need to enroll?

Go through this list of questions to find out.

If you answer **NO** your coverage will remain the same for 2008, except:

- You will not be enrolled in the Health Care or Dependent Day Care Spending Account.
- Coverage will end on December 31 for any dependent students between ages 19 and 23.
- You will not receive a Child Care Subsidy Grant, even if you applied and were awarded a grant.
- You pay the 2008 rates.
